| 5. Charge | (v.) to attack by rushing violently (n.) an attack <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym – (v.) to assault; (n.) invasion • Antonym- (v.) to retreat; (n.) conclusion |
| 6. Gag | (v.) to put a piece of cloth over a person's mouth to prevent them from speaking <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym – muzzle, muffle • Antonym – allow speaking |
| 7. Jest | (n.) a joke, a mockery <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym – laugh, wisecrack • Antonym – compliment |
| 8. Reel | (v.) to wobble, spin around <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym – stagger, teeter • Antonym – steady |
| 9. Strive | (v.) to try for, to make a great effort <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym- go all out • Antonym- neglect, surrender <p>*past tense - <i>strove</i></p> |
| 10. Writhe | (v.) to twist or move painfully <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Synonym – agonize • Antonym – be still |
